

Licensing — Pricing and Benefits

Kruse Training is an online program that provides training to injection molding engineers. Because of the program's multi-level approach, Kruse Training is a valuable tool for a wide array of professionals, from entry-level to experienced engineers. Kruse Training is designed for part and mold designers, mold makers, and molders – basically everyone in the injection molding industry.

ANNUAL LICENSE OPTION:

The table below outlines the individual and group pricing for one year. This license provides unlimited access to all Kruse Training materials. Each user has a dedicated account and maintains that account through the duration of the license. All users are eligible for certification upon completion of each level and passing final exam grade.

FLEXIBLE LICENSE OPTION:

The two-year flexible license program is designed to mitigate training costs for organizations with large engineering teams. The flexible license grants each user's account to be re-assigned to another engineer every six months. While each user has their dedicated account, they are eligible for certification upon completion of each level and passing final exam grade.

- A <u>10-user</u> flexible license allows <u>40 users</u> to complete the program in a 2-year period (10 users every 6-months).
- A <u>25-user</u> flexible license allows <u>100 users</u> to complete the program in a 2-year period (25 users every 6- months
- A <u>50-user</u> flexible license allows <u>200 users</u> to complete the program in a 2-year period (50 users every 6 months)

Comparison with other training options:

Off-site in-person or one-time online seminars:

- The estimated cost for 1 individual to attend a 3-day offsite seminar is \$1,500. Factoring
 in travel expenses and lost work hours, the estimated average cost for a 3-day seminar is
 \$3,000 per individual.
- Seminars are one-time events that are not designed to be consistent and continuous learning opportunities.

DVD training

- Pricing for DVD-based single seat license training can range from \$750 for a 2-DVD course to \$20,000+ for multi-subject courses or training "libraries."
- Single seat licenses for DVD training are intended for one individual at a time; a multi-seat DVD training system is generally costlier and requires a multi-computer dedicated training space and scheduling during business hours.
- Combining training records in a multi-seat and multi-computer environment can be challenging.
- New content or changes to existing content requires purchases of additional DVDs or other supplemental materials.
